2022 SBU AMBASSADOR'S BALL MAJOR PRIZE DRAW CRITICAL INFORMATION, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

DRAW BACKGROUND

The StandbyU Foundation is an Australian Registered Charity with a head office in Brisbane, Queensland. SBU Community Partner James Frizelle Foundation has donated a 'major cash prize' for one recipient, to be drawn at the StandbyU Foundation 2022 Ambassador's Ball, held in Brisbane.

DRAW DATE

Saturday, September 24, 2022.

DRAW LOCATION

Plaza Ballroom, Brisbane Convention & Exhibition Centre

DRAW OWNER

SBU Executive Director Chris Boyle will oversee the electronic draw during the Ambassador's Ball event. In the event Executive Director Boyle is unavailable or unable to undertake the draw, SBU Practice Development Manager Nathan Gallagher will oversee the electronic draw.

PRIZE AMOUNT

The 'major cash prize' is Twenty-Five-Thousand-Dollars (\$25 000) AU currency.

TICKETS & ENTRY

- There will be maximum 1000 entries
- The price of one entry is \$100 AU (Transaction Fee included in total price)
- There is a limit of three (3) entries per person
- The ticket form is via electronic webpage and email confirmation of entry there will be no physical ticket provided
- Payment of the entry amount will be via secure credit card portal

ELIGIBILITY

- All entry-purchasing individuals, entities or organisations must be Australian residents and over the age of eighteen (18).
- Tickets must be purchased using the Ambassador's Ball Ticket Portal, provided by OzTix
- The selected prize winner will be required to present an Australian Passport or Driver's Licence for confirming legal identity to the Draw Owner prior to the prize being awarded
- All Ambassador's Ball ticket holders are guaranteed the opportunity to purchase a minimum of one entry in the Cash Prize Draw. In the event that external and online entries exceed 200 of the 1000 allocated entries, entry without proof of an Ambassador's Ball ticket will be temporarily suspended to ensure adequate access.

GROSS AMOUNT AND EXPENSES

Upon the maximum amount of 1000 entries being exhausted, the anticipated Gross Profit from the draw is \$100 000 (AU). Upon the maximum amount of 1000 entries being exhausted, the anticipated total draw-related expenses are \$0.

DRAW OPEN AND CLOSE DATES

The Draw portal for purchase of tickets will open at 12:00am 7 July 2022 and close at 8pm on 24 September, 2022.

DRAW PROCESS

The draw will be conducted via the Gleam Random Name Picker cloud software (<u>www.gleam.io</u>). All entry names will be entered into the Gleam system via StandbyU Foundation's Account Portal. One SBU Staff Member will enter the names whilst Draw Owner Executive Director Chris Boyle is present and overseeing the data entry process. One other SBU Staff Member will check and confirm all names have been entered. On the Draw Date, the 'Draw Winners' process will be commenced by the Draw Owner and the result of the draw will be electronically captured and stored.

DRAW NOTIFICATION

StandbyU Foundation will advise the prize draw winner in person, on the night the draw is undertaken. In the event the draw winner is not present in person at the Draw Location, StandbyU Foundation will attempt to contact the prize draw winner by telephone, then via email. The prize winner will be required to present to the StandbyU Foundation Head Office to confirm identification (if not available on the day of the draw). The prize winner has twelve (12) months to claim the prize. After this period, SBU can apply the prize or its sale proceeds to the association's purposes.

CLAIMING AND DELIVERY

The total monetary amount of the cash prize will be paid following the draw date, via electronic transfer, into an Australian Bank Account, nominated by the drawn prize winner within fourteen (14) days of the full account details being provided in writing to StandbyU Foundation. The bank account provided for payment of the prize amount must be facilitated by an Australian registered banking institution. The Account Name must match the Full Name or the prize winner as represented on the Australian Passport of Driver's Licence sighted by the Draw Owner.

DRAW COMMUNICATION

The existence of the Draw will be publicly communicated using print, web, social media, radio, verbal and other mediums of marketing and communication as deemed appropriate by the SBU Ambassador's Ball Organising Committee.

The Prize Draw Winner's first name and image will be published on some or all of the above communication mediums following the draw's completion, unless the Ambassador's Ball Organising Committee deems it appropriate not to publish the name and image of the prize draw winner for any reason.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Entry is only available to Australian Residents over the age of eighteen (18);
- 2. The right to the prize is not transferable or assignable to any other person;
- 3. Any details of individuals captured using the electronic form pertaining to the draw and draw process, will be kept, stored, used and protected in accordance with our Privacy Policy;
- 4. StandbyU Foundation will not be liable for any loss, expense, damage or injury sustained by any entrant in connection with this prize draw, the prize or redemption of the prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law (in which case, that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law);
- 5. StandbyU Foundation may suspend, cease or cancel the promotion or draw process if it determines at any time the integrity, legality or administration of the promotion and draw has been adversely affected by any circumstances. StandbyU Foundation may disqualify any individual who is found to tamper with, negatively affect or unethically or unlawfully influence the integrity of the process or draw.
